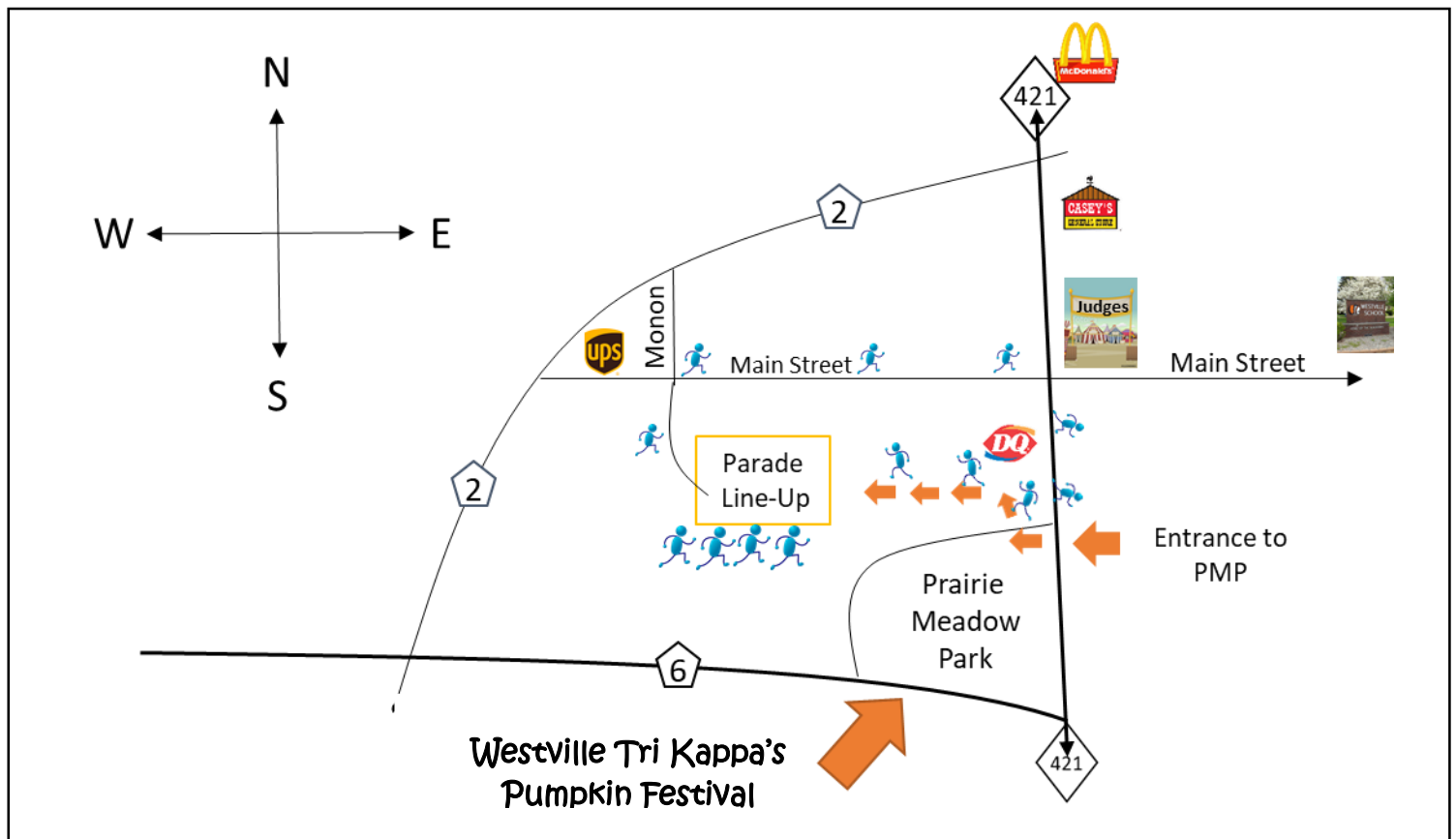

The Westville Pumpkin Festival Committee is delighted to Welcome you to join us in the fun at our 2019 Pumpkin Festival Parade. For this year's parade, we have included a few guidelines to assist in a smooth and safe take-off. Please take a moment to read the information below which is applicable to all entries.

The safety of children is very important to us, so if your entry includes children, please pay special attention to the following:

- Please have a designated meeting area and time for your group to meet. Make sure your group is together **before** entering the lineup.
- Please do not expect parade officials to watch your children. If a child is lost, he/she will be taken directly to the Tri Kappa tent where the police officer on duty will be notified.
- If possible, provide a way for younger children to ride instead of walking through the parade.
- Please make sure the children of your group know your entry name.

Contest: At the time of registration, you will be given a number to identify your entry. Your number must be in plain sight located on the left side of your entry as you pass the judging area which is located at the corner of Main street & Flynn Road. Prizes will be announced at approximately 12:00 pm after the parade at the Tri Kappa Pumpkin Festival.

Entries are judged on decorations, entertainment value, originality, and creativity.

Horses: Please provide clean up service throughout the parade route. Please do not bring horse trailers into the lineup area.

Extra Vehicles/Trailers: Because of our limited space for line-up, please do not bring any hauling trailers or any non-entry vehicles into the line-up area.
